Believing that all are created in the image of God, Greenwood Hills Boys' Camp is committed to each camper and staff member being treated with respect, valued as a person and being physically and emotionally safe. As staff, we work together as a team to ensure that campers gain self-confidence, make new friends, and go home with great memories.

Bullying is when a person or group of people want to have power over another and use their power to get their way at the expense of someone else. Some examples of bullying are when one or more people exclude, tease in a mean way, taunt, swear at, spread rumors about, hit, kick, put down another with the intent to hurt or encourage others to "gang up" on another person.

Bullying will not be tolerated and will result in the following disciplinary steps:

1st time: the persons involved will speak with the director and counselor about the situation. 2nd time: the camper that has bullied another will call his parent(s) in the presence of the director and explain what he has done.

3rd time: the parent(s) will be expected, within an agreed upon time, to take their child home.

Or in the case of any type of physical assault/fighting, the parent(s) must promptly come to get their son.
