Things Not to Bring

Campers are divided into 3 age groups for Bible Studies & some activities. Cabins have a capacity of 12 for older girls, 7 for younger girls (all with indoor bathrooms).

Clothing: Please mark all clothing, linens, and personal belongings, especially towels and underwear. Children do not always recognize their own items. Send as few items as necessary to last the entire length of camp. No laundry service is available. See the section titled "What to wear at camp" on your confirmation email.

Sickness: We have a team of registered nurses on the campgrounds during Girls Camp. Parents will receive a phone call for any of the following illness or injury: a camper develops a fever that is not easily resolved by medication, they sustain a concerning head injury, an epi-pen is administered, for any unusual vomiting, or it is determined that they need to be taken to Urgent Care/Emergency Department.

Medical Note: Greenwood Hills is unable to provide special diets and meals, nor to provide personalized attention to girls with severe allergies, or with severe medical or behavioral issues.

Insurance Policy: All claims must be submitted to the camper's insurance company first. Any deductible and unpaid balance may then be submitted under GHBCA's limited insurance policy for injuries incurred during approved activities.

Cabinmate Requests: both campers MUST request each other and MUST be within a year of each other's age. These MUST be received on the camper application, or requested before camp by emailing GWHgirlscomp@yahoo.com. Cabin assignments **cannot be changed on the day of registration**. We try to honor all requests, (especially with new campers) if received one week before camp begins.

Cancellations: Due to the waitlist, please contact the director at gwhgcreg@gmail.com as soon as possible, if you are canceling. If you do not cancel prior to registration day, you will automatically be charged the total camp fee.

Telephone calls: Girls are not permitted to make or receive calls during camp. However, the director will contact parents and receive calls in cases of emergency.
